AN ACT MAKING CERTAIN REPORTS A MATTER OF PUBLIC RECORD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law or rule to the contrary,
2 any reports, findings or any other documentary evidence gath-
3 ered as a result of any investigation of labor-management rela-
4 tions conducted by any department or division of any agency of
5 the commonwealth shall be a matter of public record.
