By Mr. Brett of Quincy, petition of Joseph E. Brett that provision be made for state reimbursement of one half of the cost of construction of public transportation facilities by cities, towns or transportation districts. Transportation.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE REIMBURSEMENT BY THE COMMONWEALTH OF ONE HALF OF THE COST OF THE CONSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION FACILITIES BY CITIES OR TOWNS OR TRANSPORTATION DISTRICTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law
2 to the contrary, the commonwealth shall reimburse each city
3 and town and transportation district authorized by the general
4 court to construct public transportation facilities one half of the
5 cost of the construction of said public transportation facilities
6 exclusive of any federal aid.

By the Clerk of the House, Joseph E. Smith, that passage be made for
 the consideration of the bill of the House of Representatives for the transportation
 of the mails, roads or transportation facilities.
