The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Three.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING UNIFORM PARKING RATES IN THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 No person operating a public parking facility which is owned,
2 leased or licensed by the city of Boston shall charge in excess of
3 the following amounts for the following times for the parking of
4 motor vehicles: the charge for the first hour shall not be more
5 than fifty cents and not more than one dollar and fifty cents for
6 any eight hour period from eight o'clock antemeridian to twelve
7 o'clock postmeridian or for any eight hour period between
8 twelve o'clock postmeridian and eight o'clock antemeridian.
9 Any person who violates any provision of this act shall be pun-
10 ished by a fine of not more than one hundred dollars.
