AN ACT REPEALING PROVISIONS PROHIBITING EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR CIVIL SERVICE POSITIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section six A of chapter thirty-one, inserted by chapter two hundred and twenty-eight of the acts of nineteen hundred and three thirty-five, is hereby repealed.
