AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO  
CONSTRUCT A WADING POOL AT FORT PHOENIX BEACH IN THE  
TOWN OF FAIRHAVEN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The department of public works is hereby authorized and
- 2 directed to construct and maintain a salt water wading pool at
- 3 Fort Phoenix beach in the town of Fairhaven. For such pur-
- 4 poses, said commission may expend such sums as may be ap-
- 5 propriated therefor.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO  
 ESTABLISH A BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS TO BE KNOWN AS THE  
 BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
 Conference assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. The department of public works is hereby established and  
 divided to consist and maintain a self-sustaining board of  
 five persons to be known as the Board of Public Works. The board  
 shall have and exercise such powers and duties as may be  
 required to carry out the purposes of this act.
