## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

### AN ACT INCREASING THE MONTHLY TRANSPORTATION ALLOWANCE UNDER THE OLD AGE ASSISTANCE LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 1 of chapter 118A of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out the third paragraph, as most recently  
3 amended by section 1 of chapter 728 of the acts of 1955, and  
4 inserting in place thereof the following paragraph: —

5 Each local board of public welfare shall include in the budget  
6 of each recipient an item, to be known as “Leisure Time Activi-  
7 ties”, under which there shall be paid to each recipient the sum  
8 of four dollars monthly in addition to the budgetary require-  
9 ments or any other assistance granted under the provisions of  
10 this section and an item, to be known as “Transportation  
11 Allowance”, under which there shall be paid to each recipient  
12 who is not an inmate of a nursing home or institution the sum  
13 of seven dollars monthly.
