AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DIVISION OF WATERWAYS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO MAKE REPAIRS AND ALTERATIONS TO THE STATE FISH PIER LOCATED IN THE CITY OF GLOUCESTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The division of waterways of the department of public works is
2 hereby authorized and directed to make such repairs and alter-
3 ations to the state fish pier, located in the city of Gloucester,
4 which in its opinion are necessary and proper for the fullest
5 utilization of said facility. Said division may expend for the
6 purposes of this act such sums as may be appropriated therefor,
7 not to exceed one hundred thousand dollars.
