AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RE-EMPLOYMENT OF RETIRED SCHOOL TEACHERS WITHOUT LOSS OF PENSION RIGHTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 91 of chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out the last sentence, added by chapter 291
3 of the acts of 1957, and inserting in place thereof the following
4 sentence:—Such employment shall not affect the pension
5 rights or amount of pension of any such teacher, provided that
6 the total annual salary received therefrom does not exceed two
7 thousand dollars.
