AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY THAT MAY BE HELD BY CERTAIN VETERANS' ORGANIZATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 5 of chapter 59 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by striking out clause fifth, as appearing in the Tercentenary
3 Edition, and inserting in place thereof the following clause: —
4 Fifth, The real and personal estate belonging to or held in
5 trust for the benefit of incorporated organizations of veterans of
6 any war in which the United States has been engaged, to the
7 extent of two hundred thousand dollars, if actually used and
8 occupied by such association, and if the net income from said
9 property is used for charitable purposes; but it shall not be
10 exempt for any year in which such association or the trustees
11 holding for the benefit of such association wilfully omit to bring
12 in to the assessors the list and statement required by section
13 twenty-nine.
