AN ACT RELATIVE TO A NEW COURTHOUSE FOR THE DISTRICT COURT OF SOMERVILLE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The commissioners of the county of Middlesex are hereby
2 authorized and directed to construct in the city of Somerville
3 a new building for the carrying on of the business of the district
4 court of Somerville.

5 In determining the site for said building, the said commis-
6 sioners are directed to confer with the proper officials of the
7 city of Somerville.

8 For said purpose the commissioners are authorized to spend
9 such sums as may hereafter be appropriated.
