McEvoy, Jr., that the Commissioner of Insurance be prohibited from establishing separate motor vehicle liability insurance rates for operators of motor vehicles who are under the age of twenty-five if such operators have not been involved in an accident. AN ACT RELATIVE TO AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE RATES FOR UNDER AGE TWENTY-FIVE OPERATORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The commissioner of insurance is prohibited from establishing
2 separate automobile insurance rates for any automobile operated
3 by a person under age twenty-five, if the operator under age
4 twenty-five has been duly licensed to operate a vehicle for three
5 years, and has not been involved in any accident in which the
6 registrar of motor vehicles has found the said operator to be at
7 fault.

AN ACT TO AMEND AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REGULATION OF THE
MOTOR-VEHICLE BUSINESS.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the Governor of the State, as follows:

1. The commissioner of insurance is prohibited from authorizing
2. any person to operate a motor vehicle for any amount of time
3. in a public place, unless he is a person under age
4. twenty-one, has been duly licensed to operate a vehicle for three
5. years and has not been involved in any accident in which the
6. operator of motor vehicle has found the said operator to be at
7. fault.
