AN ACT REQUIRING EMPLOYERS TO MAKE CERTAIN REPORTS UPON
THE OCCURRENCE OF AN ACCIDENT TO AN EMPLOYEE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 19 of chapter 152 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after the second sentence the following
3 sentence: — Upon the occurrence of an accident involving in-
4 jury to an employee, the employer shall make a report of such
5 accident in triplicate, retaining one copy for himself, forwarding
6 one copy to the employee and the remaining copy to the insur-
7 ance company which carries the insurance for such type of
8 accident.

The Commission of Specimens
