RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE RATES CHARGED BY THE BOSTON EDISON COMPANY FOR ITS SERVICES.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to consist of  
2 two members of the senate, three members of the house of repre-  
3 sentatives, and two persons to be appointed by the governor, is  
4 hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation  
5 and study relative to the rates charged by the Boston Edison  
6 Company for its services and to compare them with rates charged  
7 by similar utilities for similar services.
