which fulfills the requirement of section one of this act and has been approved by said actuary. Such revised amount shall be in accordance with an approved actuarial funding schedule; provided, however, that any such schedule shall be submitted to said actuary on or before June first, nineteen hundred and ninety-two and the resulting revised appropriation shall be issued by said actuary no later than June fifteenth, nineteen hundred and ninety-two.

**SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect upon its passage.

**Chapter 86.**

**AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF NEWTON TO ACCEPT AND ACT UPON LATE APPLICATIONS FOR CLASSIFICATION AS RECREATIONAL LAND.**

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

**SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding the provisions of section three of chapter sixty-one B of the General Laws or any other general or special law to the contrary, the board of assessors of the city of Newton is authorized to receive and act upon the applications of the Woodland Golf Club for classification as recreational land for tax year nineteen hundred and ninety-one and nineteen hundred and ninety-two provided such applications are filed with the board of assessors no later than thirty days from the effective date of this act.

**SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect upon its passage.

**Chapter 87.**

**AN ACT RELATIVE TO CHILDREN BORN OR DIAGNOSED WITH MENTAL RETARDATION.**

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Section 67E of chapter 111 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-

Within ten days after the date of birth of any child with mental retardation, or within ten days after any child has been diagnosed as having mental retardation, the hospital wherein such birth or diagnosis has occurred shall report, with the approval of the parents, such mental retardation to the department of mental retardation for the purpose of having said department inform such parents of existing information and support services. The contents of such report shall be solely for the use as described herein and shall not be open to public inspection
