AN ACT TO INCREASE THE SALARY OF THE COMMISSIONER OF ADMINISTRATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 4 of chapter 7 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by section 4 of chapter 757 of the acts of 1962, is hereby
3 further amended by striking out the first two sentences and in-
4 serting in place thereof the following: — The governor shall ap-
5 point a commissioner of administration, who shall be a person of
6 ability and experience. He shall serve at the pleasure of the
7 governor, shall receive such salary not exceeding twenty-five
8 thousand per year as the governor may determine, and shall
9 devote his entire time to the duties of his office.
