AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE RELOCATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of agriculture is hereby directed to relocate
2 all of its offices presently located in the city of Boston to the
3 building under the control of said department at the Brockton
4 Fair grounds in the city of Brockton. There is hereby appropri-
5 ated the sum of twenty five thousand dollars from the Agri-
6 cultural Purposes Fund for the cost of surveys and plans to
7 effectuate such relocation, and such other sums as may be ap-
8 propriated for the renovation, alteration and remodeling of said
9 department's building in said city of Brockton.
