By Mr. Quinn of Boston, petition of Adolph H. Braunies and Robert H. Quinn relative to local taxation of certain lands of the Massachusetts Port Authority upon which business is being conducted for private profit. Taxation.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Three.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TAXATION OF CERTAIN LANDS OF THE MASSACHUSETTS PORT AUTHORITY ON WHICH PRIVATE BUSINESSES ARE CONDUCTED FOR PROFIT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 17 of chapter 465 of the acts of 1956 is hereby amended
2 by inserting after the word "hereof", in line 37, the words: —
3 and provided further that, anything herein to the contrary
4 notwithstanding, any other land of the Authority upon which
5 business is being conducted for private profit shall be taxed
6 under section three A of chapter fifty-nine of the General Laws
7 as if such land were real estate owned by the commonwealth.
