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### RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF G. K. HALL & CO. OF BOSTON.

1 *Resolved*, That, for the purpose of discharging a usual obliga-  
2 tion of the commonwealth there shall be allowed and paid out  
3 of the state treasury, subject to appropriation, to G. K. Hall  
4 & Co. of Boston, the sum of fifteen thousand dollars for work  
5 performed at the request of the secretary of the commonwealth  
6 in connection with the design and installation of the coding and  
7 filing systems for the handling of paperwork for the Uniform  
8 Commercial Code.

THE ENVIRONMENTAL IMPROVEMENT ACT

Enacted by the 95th General Assembly, 1977

Chapter 145, Illinois Compiled Statutes

Section 1. The purpose of this Act is to provide for the improvement of the environment and to provide for the protection of the public health, safety and welfare. This Act shall be known and may be cited as the Environmental Improvement Act.

Section 2. The Environmental Improvement Act shall apply to all persons who are engaged in the business of manufacturing, processing, distributing, or otherwise handling any substance which is listed in the schedule of hazardous materials established by the Department of Health and Environmental Conservation.
