

# HOUSE . . . . . No. 2359

By Mr. Colonna of Framingham (by request), petition of Thomas W. Gilligan and another that the Commissioner of Correction be authorized to grant to him and Joseph F. Greeley an easement over certain state land in the town of Framingham. Public Welfare.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Three.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COMMISSIONER OF CORRECTION TO GRANT AN EASEMENT OVER CERTAIN LAND OF THE COMMONWEALTH IN THE TOWN OF FRAMINGHAM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The commissioner of correction, in the name and on behalf  
2 of the commonwealth, is hereby authorized to grant to Joseph  
3 F. Greeley and Thomas W. Gilligan the following described  
4 easement over land owned by the commonwealth in the town of  
5 Framingham:—

6 The easterly location line of the easement begins at a point  
7 on the northerly location line of Merchant road, a public way in  
8 the town of Framingham, which point also marks the easterly  
9 bank of Course brook, so-called; thence the easterly line of the  
10 easement runs in a northeasterly direction along the easterly  
11 bank of Course brook, 600.00 feet more or less to land now or  
12 formerly of Andrew Jensen, Jr.

13 The westerly location line of the easement is located parallel to  
14 and 50.00 feet westerly of the above described easterly location  
15 line of the easement.
