AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THAT A ROOF BE CONSTRUCTED
OVER THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION SKATING RINK
IN THE CITY OF MEDFORD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby authorized
- 2 and directed to construct a roof over its skating rink in the city
- 3 of Medford. For the purposes of this act the said commission
- 4 may expend such sums as are appropriated therefor.

The Constitution of the State

The Constitution of the State is a document which sets forth the fundamental principles and the organization of the government.
