AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO CONSTRUCT A SKATING RINK AND A FOOTBALL STADIUM IN THE CHARLESTOWN DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF BOSTON AS PART OF THE URBAN RENEWAL PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan district commission is hereby
2 authorized and directed to construct a skating rink and a foot-
3 ball stadium, and thereafter maintain such facilities, in the
4 Charlestown district of the city of Boston. For such purposes,
5 the said commission may use such funds as may be appropriated
6 therefor.

1 SECTION 2. The cost of the construction of the skating rink
2 and the football stadium shall be part of the commonwealth's
3 financial assistance for any urban renewal program of the
4 Charlestown district of the city of Boston as provided for in
5 chapter one hundred and twenty-one of the General Laws.
