AN ACT REQUIRING THE PLACING OF A SUITABLE COVER OVER SAND AND GRAVEL CARRIED IN ANY TRUCK ON THE PUBLIC WAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 13 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as most re-
2 cently amended by chapter 763 of the acts of 1950, is hereby
3 further amended by inserting at the end thereof the following
4 sentence:— A suitable cover shall be placed over all sand and
5 gravel carried in any truck on the public way.
