MacLean, Jr., and others for legislation to authorize a person receiving a pension or retirement allowance from the Commonwealth or subdivision thereof to also receive compensation for services rendered in a position to which he is appointed by a board of public welfare. AN ACT AUTHORIZING A PERSON RECEIVING A PENSION OR RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE FROM THE COMMONWEALTH OR ANY OF ITS POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS TO ALSO RECEIVE COMPENSATION FOR SERVICES RENDERED IN A POSITION TO WHICH HE IS APPOINTED BY A BOARD OF PUBLIC WELFARE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 91 of chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out the second sentence, as most recently
3 amended by chapter 549 of the acts of 1954, and inserting in
4 place thereof the following sentence:—Notwithstanding the
5 foregoing provisions of this section or similar provisions of any
6 special law, a person who, while receiving such a pension or
7 retirement allowance, is appointed for a term of years to a
8 position by the governor with or without the advice and consent
9 of the council or is appointed for a term of years to a position
10 by the mayor or city manager of any city with or without con-
11 firmation by the city council or in Plan E cities is elected for a
12 term of years to a position by the city council or is appointed to a
13 position in a town and serves in such position under the direction
14 of the selectmen or board of public welfare thereof, shall be paid
15 the compensation attached to the position to which he is ap-
16 pointed or elected; provided, that he files with the treasurer of
17 the governmental unit paying such pension or allowance, a
18 written statement wherein he waives and renounces for himself,
19 his heirs and his legal representatives, his right to receive the
20 same for the period during which such compensation is payable.
