AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES OF PERSONS UNDER DISABILITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first paragraph of section 91A of chapter 32 of the General
2 Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 303 of the acts of
3 1961, is hereby further amended by inserting after the second
4 sentence the following sentence:— If, however, the amount of
5 such earnings, or when added to his adjusted pension or retire-
6 ment allowance in such preceding year, is less than the amount
7 of regular compensation which would have been payable to such
8 person in such preceding year had he continued in service in the
9 grade held by him at the time he was pensioned or retired, the
10 difference between the two amounts shall be deducted from the
11 amount of his earnings in every subsequent year in which he
12 would be required to make a refund, provided that the aforesaid
13 difference between the two amounts may not be so applied for
14 more than a period of five years after the year in which the
15 difference arose.
