AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF NATICK TO SUPPLY THE TOWN OF WAYLAND WITH WATER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Natick may furnish from its water
2 supply to the inhabitants of the town of Wayland within two
3 hundred feet of the town line between said towns a supply of
4 water for the use of said inhabitants for domestic and other
5 purposes and may contract with said inhabitants for such sup-
6 ply of water on such terms as may be determined and estab-
7 lished by the board of public works of the said town of Natick.
8 Such contract may provide, among other things, that said
9 town of Natick shall have the right to assess to any inhabitant
10 of the town of Wayland to whom water is supplied under the
11 authority of this act, the cost of extending such water supply
12 to his land, which cost shall include the cost of the pipes and
13 other material and of the labor in laying them and other ex-
14 penses incidental thereto which shall be ascertained, assessed
15 and certified by the board of public works of said town.

1 SECTION 2. The town of Natick shall have such rights against
2 any inhabitant of the town of Wayland, to whom water is being
3 supplied and whose bill for such services is not paid on or before
4 its due date, as are provided by sections forty-two A to forty-
5 two E, inclusive, of chapter forty of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by
2 the town of Natick.
