## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Three.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO ASSUME CONTROL OF CERTAIN LAND AND CONSTRUCT RECREATIONAL FACILITIES THEREON IN THE ROXBURY DISTRICT OF BOSTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby authorized  
2 and directed to enter into an agreement with the city of Boston  
3 for the purchase of certain property located on Norfolk avenue  
4 in the Roxbury district, such property known as the William  
5 Eustis playground. The metropolitan district commission is  
6 further authorized and directed that upon acquiring title to said  
7 property it shall assume control and maintenance thereof. For  
8 said purpose said commission may expend such sums as may be  
9 appropriated therefor.
