AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A HIGH LEVEL BRIDGE
ACROSS THE DANVERS RIVER CONNECTING THE CITIES OF BEVERLY
AND SALEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of public works is hereby authorized and
2 directed to construct and maintain a high level bridge across
3 the Danvers river, connecting public highways in the cities of
4 Salem and Beverly, in a location in the vicinity of the present
5 Beverly-Salem bridge. For said purpose, the department may
6 expend the sum of seven million five hundred thousand dollars
7 and shall determine the location and design which meets the
8 requirements of the community and the commonwealth.
