RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION BY THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL RELATIVE TO PROVIDING THAT NEGLIGENCE OF AN OPERATOR OF A MOTOR VEHICLE SHALL NOT BE IMPUTED TO THE OWNER.

1 *Resolved*, That the judicial council be requested to investi-
2 gate the subject matter of current senate document numbered
3 267, relative to providing that negligence of an operator of a
4 motor vehicle shall not be imputed to the owner, and to include
5 its conclusions and its recommendations, if any, in relation there-
6 to, together with drafts of such legislation as may be necessary
7 to give effect to the same, in its annual report for the current
8 year.
