RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE RETIREMENT LAW COMMISSION PROVIDING FOR A GUARANTEED MINIMUM RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE ON THE COMPLETION OF FORTY YEARS OF CREDITABLE SERVICE.

1 *Resolved*, That the Retirement Law Commission is hereby  
2 authorized and directed to make an investigation and study of  
3 the subject matter of current house document numbered 1040,  
4 providing for a guaranteed minimum retirement allowance on  
5 the completion of forty years of creditable service. Said com-  
6 mission shall report to the general court the results of its in-  
7 vestigation and study, and its recommendations, if any, to-  
8 gether with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its recom-  
9 mendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the  
10 house of representatives on or before the fourth Wednesday of  
11 December in the current year.
