AN ACT MAKING PERMANENT CERTAIN POSITIONS IN THE CIVIL DEFENSE AGENCY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. To provide for certain civil service positions in
2 the civil defense agency, the item authorized in section two of
3 this act, as amended, is hereby authorized subject to the provi-
4 sions of law regulating the disbursement of public funds and
5 the conditions pertaining to appropriations in chapter five hun-
6 dred of the acts of the current year for the fiscal year ending
7 June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and sixty-four.
