The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Three.

AN ACT VALIDATING CERTAIN ACTION TAKEN BY THE TOWN OF HADLEY RELATIVE TO THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF A SEWERAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM IN SAID TOWN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The acceptance of chapter eight of the acts of
2 nineteen hundred and sixty-three by the voters of the town of
3 Hadley at their nineteen hundred and sixty-three annual meet-
4 ing is confirmed in all respects notwithstanding the fact that
5 chapter eight of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-three
6 was approved by the governor subsequent to the issue and post-
7 ing of the warrant for the said annual meeting.

1 SECTION 2. All votes passed by the town of Hadley under
2 articles twenty-two through twenty-seven, inclusive, of the war-
3 rant for the nineteen hundred and sixty three annual meeting
4 whereby the town voted to authorize the selectmen to act as
5 sewer commissioners, to acquire land for sewer purposes, to
6 apply for federal aid for sewer works, and to finance such works
7 are validated in all respects; and all obligations heretofore
8 incurred, payments heretofore made or actions heretofore taken
9 pursuant to such votes are fully ratified; and bonds or notes
10 of the town may be issued pursuant to the vote under said
11 article twenty-seven.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
