1 *Resolved*, That a special commission to consist of one member

4 of the metropolitan district commission or his designee, the  
5 chairman of the water resources commission or his designee, a  
6 representative of the city of Worcester to be designated by the  
7 city manager thereof, and a representative of each of the towns  
8 of Boylston, Holden, Leicester, Paxton, Princeton, Rutland and  
9 West Boylston, to be designated by the board of selectmen  
10 thereof, is hereby established for the purpose of making an in-  
11 vestigation and study relative to the establishment of a Metro-  
12 politan Worcester Pollution Abatement District.
