## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Five.

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH OF THE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF SEWAGE IN CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES IN THE COUNTY OF WORCESTER.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of public health is hereby  
2 authorized and directed to make an investigation and study rela-  
3 tive to the collection, treatment and disposal of sanitary sewage  
4 and industrial wastes originating in the city of Worcester and the  
5 towns of Boylston, Holden, Leicester, Paxton, Princeton, Rut-  
6 land and West Boylston and to prepare a plan and estimates of  
7 the costs thereof.

8 The department shall have access to all plans, reports and  
9 specifications of said city and towns and of any person, corpora-  
10 tion or industry located therein relative to sewerage, sewage and  
11 industrial waste treatment and the disposal of the same. For  
12 the purpose of this resolve the department may employ such  
13 engineering consultants and other assistants as may be necessary  
14 and may expend such sums as may be appropriated therefor.  
15 Said department shall report its findings and recommendations,  
16 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry out such  
17 recommendations, by filing the same with the clerk of the house  
18 of representatives on or before the first Wednesday of December  
19 nineteen hundred and sixty-six.
