By Mr. Foley of Springfield, petition of Bernard J. Pat Foley for legislation to repeal provisions of law requiring the city of Springfield to install fire gongs or emergency lighting in certain buildings in said city. Cities.

AN ACT PREVENTING THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD FROM REQUIRING THE INSTALLATION OF FIRE GONGS OR EMERGENCY LIGHTING IN CERTAIN BUILDINGS IN SAID CITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter three hundred and
2 forty-nine of the acts of nineteen hundred and ten, the city of
3 Springfield shall not require the installation of fire gongs or
4 emergency lighting in any building in said city, classified as type
5 1A, 1B or 1C under the building code of said city.
