## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT PROVIDING LIFE TENURE FOR KENNETH S. WEBBER, INCUMBENT OF THE OFFICE OF CITY AUDITOR OF THE CITY OF GLOUCESTER.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The tenure of office of Kenneth S. Webber in-  
2 cumbent of the office of city auditor of the city of Gloucester,  
3 shall, on the effective date of this act, be unlimited, but he  
4 may be removed therefrom for cause, after hearing in the  
5 manner provided by section forty-three of chapter thirty-one  
6 of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by  
2 the city of Gloucester.
