### RESOLUTIONS ON THE SEVENTEENTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE FOUNDING OF THE STATE OF ISRAEL.

1 *Whereas*, This year will mark the seventeenth anniversary of  
2 the founding of the State of Israel; and

3 *Whereas*, The government of the United States was the first  
4 nation of the world to give official recognition to said State of  
5 Israel; and

6 *Whereas*, The State of Israel is a fellow Democracy and a  
7 bulwark of strength to the free world in the Middle East; there-  
8 fore be it

9 *Resolved*, That the General Court of the Commonwealth of  
10 Massachusetts hereby extends its greetings and best wishes to  
11 the State of Israel upon the seventeenth anniversary of the State  
12 of Israel; and be it further

13 *Resolved*, That a copy of these resolutions be forwarded by  
14 the Secretary of the Commonwealth to the State of Israel.
