PROPOSAL FOR A LEGISLATIVE AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION PROVIDING FOR THE INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT OF CITIES AND TOWNS.

1 A majority of all the members elected to the Senate and House
2 of Representatives, in joint session, hereby declares it to be ex-
3 pedient to alter the Constitution by the adoption of the following
4 Article of Amendment, to the end that it may become a part of
5 the Constitution [if similarly agreed to in a joint session of the
6 next General Court and approved by the people at the state
7 election next following]:

8 ARTICLE OF AMENDMENT.

9 Article . . . Article X of Part One of the Constitution, as
10 amended, is hereby further amended by adding at the end the
11 following paragraph:—

12 The industrial development of cities and towns is a public
13 function and the Commonwealth and the cities and towns
14 therein may provide for the same in such manner as the General
15 Court may determine.
