AN ACT PROHIBITING THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES BY ANY PERSON UNDER EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 8 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as most recently
- 2 amended by chapter 745 of the acts of 1963, is hereby further
- 3 amended by striking out the second, third and fourth sentences.
