AN ACT PROVIDING FOR REIMBURSEMENT FOR LEGAL SERVICES INCURRED IN SUCCESSFUL APPEALS TO THE SUPERIOR COURT FROM ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS' DECISIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The fourth paragraph of section 21 of chapter 40A of the
2 General Laws, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 199 of the
3 acts of 1957, is hereby amended by adding at the end the fol-
4 lowing sentence: — As used in this paragraph, costs shall in-
5 clude fees paid an attorney engaged to prosecute the appeal.
