By Mr. Iannello of Boston, petition of Charles Iannello that the Boston Redevelopment Authority be directed to take by eminent domain certain land on Sharon Street in the south end section of the city of Boston and cause privately owned medium rental residential property to be erected on said land. AN ACT DIRECTING THE BOSTON REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY TO TAKE BY EMINENT DOMAIN FOR PRIVATE MEDIUM RENTAL RESIDENTIAL PURPOSES THE LAND ON BOTH SIDES OF SHARON STREET IN THE SOUTH END SECTION OF THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The Boston Redevelopment Authority is hereby directed to
2 acquire by eminent domain or otherwise the land on both sides
3 of Sharon street in the south end section of the city of Boston
4 and to cause privately owned medium rental residential prop-
5 erty to be erected on said land.

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES

Article I, Section 1

All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 1. The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.

Section 2. No Person shall be a Representative who shall not, when elected, have seven Years Residence in the United States, and who, when elected, shall not, when elected, have been seven Years a Citizen of the United States, and who, when elected, shall not, when elected, have been born in the United States, and who, when elected, shall not, when elected, have been born in the United States.
