## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Five.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO  
CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN A RECREATION CENTER IN THE CITY  
OF MEDFORD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby authorized  
2 and directed to construct and maintain a recreation center  
3 building adjacent to the department's athletic plant at the  
4 Mystic river basin section in the city of Medford. For said  
5 purposes said department may expend such sums as may be  
6 appropriated therefor.

CONSTITUTIONAL PROVISIONS

ARTICLE I, SECTION 8, CLAUSE 2
