By Mr. Brett of Quincy, petition of Joseph E. Brett that packages and cartons of cigarettes be marked "excessive use of this product may cause damage to lungs". Public Health.

The Commonwealth of Wassachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Five.

An Act providing that packages and cartons of cigarettes be marked "excessive use of this product may cause damage to lungs".

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 5 of chapter 64C of the General Laws, as appearing 2 in section 1 of chapter 547 of the acts of 1945, is hereby amended
- 3 by adding at the end thereof the following sentence: When-
- 4 ever cigarettes are received or acquired within the common-
- 5 wealth by a wholesaler, vending machine operator, unclassified
- 6 acquirer or retailer, each container of such cigarettes which is
- 7 of the conventional package or carton size for purchase by the
- 8 general public, such as a package of twenty cigarettes or a car-
- 9 ton of two hundred cigarettes, shall bear the following mark-
- 10 ing: "Excessive use of the product contained herein may
- 11 cause damage to lungs."
