AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REIMBURSEMENT BY THE COMMONWEALTH OF FIFTY PER CENT OF THE ACTUAL COST INCURRED BY A CITY, TOWN OR REGIONAL INCINERATOR DISTRICT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN INCINERATOR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the
2 commonwealth shall reimburse a city, town or regional incin-
3 erator district for fifty per cent of the actual cost incurred by it
4 for the construction of an incinerator; provided, however, that
5 all plans for the construction of said incinerator shall have been
6 approved by the state department of public health.
