AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPOINTMENT OF TEACHERS IN THE UNIVERSITIES AND COLLEGES OF THE COMMONWEALTH WHO ARE BLIND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 No appointing authority in any college or university within
- 2 the commonwealth shall refuse to elect and contract with a
- 3 candidate for a teaching position in any college or university
- 4 of the commonwealth because of such person's blindness.
