### AN ACT FURTHER CLARIFYING THE RIGHTS AND DUTIES OF CANDIDATES' WORKERS OUTSIDE POLLING PLACES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 65 of chapter 54 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after the second paragraph the follow-  
3 ing paragraph:—

4 No person shall hinder, delay or interfere with, or aid in hin-  
5 dering, delaying or interfering with, a voter within one hundred  
6 and fifty feet of the entrance of a polling place intending to in-  
7 fluence the action of the voter while on his way to a primary or  
8 election.
