AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A BRANCH OFFICE OF THE REGISTRY OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN THE CITY OF TAUNTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The registrar of motor vehicles, subject to appropriation
- 2 therefor, is hereby authorized and directed to establish and
- 3 maintain in the city of Taunton a branch office of the registry
- 4 of motor vehicles.

The Constitution of the State
