AN ACT REPEALING THE PROVISIONS OF LAW RELATIVE TO THE ESTABLISHING OF A MINIMUM CONSUMER RETAIL PRICE FOR ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section twenty-five C of chapter one hundred and thirty-eight
- 2 of the General Laws is hereby repealed.
