AN ACT AUTHORIZING CITIES AND TOWNS TO CONTRACT FOR LAUNDRY SERVICES FOR PERIODS NOT TO EXCEED THREE YEARS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 4 of chapter 40 of the General Laws is hereby amended
- 2 by inserting before the last paragraph the following paragraph: —
- 3 For laundry services contracts for municipal hospitals and
- 4 infirmaries for a period not exceeding three years.
