AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE COUNTY OF NORFOLK SHALL BE REIMBURSED BY THE COMMONWEALTH FOR ALL EXPENSES INCURRED BY SAID COUNTY IN CONNECTION WITH TRIALS FOR CERTAIN HOMICIDES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 125 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by adding at the end the following section:—

3 *Section 22.* The state treasurer, upon certification by the  
4 treasurer of the county of Norfolk, shall reimburse said county  
5 for all expenses incurred by it in connection with the trial of an  
6 inmate of any correctional institution of the commonwealth  
7 situated in said county for homicide committed in such insti-  
8 tution.

1 SECTION 2. The provisions of section twenty-two of chapter  
2 one hundred and twenty-five of the General Laws, added by  
3 section one of this act, shall not apply to any expenses incurred  
4 by the county of Norfolk prior to the effective date of this act.
