By Mr. Carney of Boston, petition of Daniel W. Carney, Joseph M. Kearney and Julius Ansel that the Metropolitan District Commission be directed to sell and convey a certain parcel of land in Boston to William D. Doyle, Veterans of Foreign Wars Post #2831. Metropolitan Affairs.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Five.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO SELL AND CONVEY A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND TO WILLIAM D. DOYLE, VETERANS OF FOREIGN WARS POST #2831, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENABLING SAID POST TO ESTABLISH A POST HEADQUARTERS THEREON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan district commission, for and in
2 behalf of the commonwealth, is hereby authorized and directed
3 to transfer and convey to William D. Doyle, Veterans of Foreign
4 Wars, Post #2831, for the purpose of enabling said post to es-
5 tablish a post headquarters thereon a certain parcel of land
6 located in the city of Boston and shown on a plan of land entitled
7 "Neponset River Reservation, Boston (Hyde Park district),
8 Parks Division, Metropolitan District Commission, Common-
9 wealth of Massachusetts, dated September twenty-first, nine-
10 teen hundred and forty-eight, Benjamin R. Davis, Direction of
11 Park Engineering" bounded and described as follows:—

12 Northerly seventy-three (73) feet by River Street; Easterly
13 one hundred and six (106) feet more or less by a parcel entitled
14 "To be leased to Tileston and Hollingsworth" on said plan;
15 Southerly seventy-nine (79) feet by the Neponset River; and
16 Westerly one hundred and thirty-five (135) feet more or less by
17 remaining land of the Metropolitan District Commission.

1 SECTION 2. The title to the land described in section one shall
2 revert to and revest in the commonwealth whenever such land
3 shall cease to be used for the purpose set forth in said section.
4 In the event that said land is not used for the purpose set forth
5 in section one within three years of the passage of this act, the
6 title to said land shall revert to and revest in the commonwealth.
